Domain 5: An Expert Teaching Team.

- Enhance staff instructional practices in the areas of literacy and communication.
- Build middle leaders' capacity to work as instructional leaders across sectors.

Domain 8: Effective Pedagogical Practices.

- Enhance staff capacity to support increased student engagement through implementation of school wide trauma informed strategies.

Domain 9: School and Community Partnerships

- Implement targeted transition programs at key school junctures (entry and between sectors) to promote student learning and well-being.
- Support Senior Students transition to post school options through provision of SETA and ASDAN courses.

Our initiatives include

- Provision of two full-time Teacher Aides to support the work of the Literacy Coach and Communication Coach.
- Funding of additional SLP time to support the embedding of school wide communication strategies.
- The provision of targeted professional development for Teacher Aides in the areas of Trauma Informed Practice.
- Funding professional development for school sector leaders and school middle leaders.
- Access to registered VET courses and certificates to increase senior student preparedness to transition successfully to post school options.
- Provision of engaging resources to enhance student's social and emotional wellbeing.
